Northeastern Utah Educational Services (NUES) is presently accepting applications for the position of Region BCBA. This will be a ten-month (205 working days) position beginning July 1, 2022.

The NUES Region BCBA will function under the direction the NUES Executive Director as governed by the NUES Board of Directors. The BCBA will provide assistance as needed across the NUES region consisting of nine school districts and five charter schools as they coordinate with special education directors and teachers to schedule and conduct behavioral evaluations, supervise region Registered Behavior Technicians (RBT) and provide training. Occasionally, services may be rendered to other rural LEAs on a limited basis.
