Northeastern Utah Educational Services (NUES) is presently accepting applications for the position of Region Crisis and PBIS Counselor. This will be a ten-month (200 working days) position beginning July 1, 2019.

The Region Crisis and PBIS Counselor will function under the direction the NUES Executive Director as governed by the NUES Board of Directors. The Counselor will provide assistance as needed across the NUES region consisting of nine school districts and four charter schools as they coordinate with special education directors and teachers to support their PBIS efforts. The Counselor will also assist region LEAs in the event of a crisis by assisting LEA staff and coordinating a response plan. Occasionally, services may be rendered to other rural LEAs on a limited basis.
