Northeastern Utah Educational Services (NUES) is presently accepting applications for the position of Region School Psychologist. This will be a ten-month (200 working days) position beginning July 1, 2019.

The School Psychologist will function under the direction the NUES Executive Director as governed by the NUES Board of Directors. The School Psychologist will provide assistance as needed across the NUES region consisting of nine school districts and four charter schools as they coordinate with special education directors and teachers to schedule and conduct psychoeducational diagnostic evaluations, provide training, and assist LEAs in complying with Federal and Utah State Special Education rules and regulations. Occasionally, services may be rendered to other rural LEAs on a limited basis.
