

NUES Behavior Specialist

(Contracted, hourly position: up to 20 hours weekly, Jan 6-June 30, 2025)

Possible extension for 2025-26 school year

Position Summary:

A NUES Behavioral Health (MBH) Specialist is a paraeducator position that will function under the direction of the NUES Executive Director as governed by the NUES Board of Directors, with supervision and consultation provided by our NUES BCBA's (Board Certified Behavior Analysts). The Behavior Specialist will provide assistance for individual districts and LEAs in the NUES region consisting of nine school districts and five charter schools. It is our intention to find Behavior Specialists for the following areas:

- Rich School District (Bear Lake area)
- Morgan School District
- Wasatch School District, Weilenmann School, Soldier Hollow School
- Duchesne School District
- Uintah School District, Terra Academy, Uintah River HS
- Daggett School District

Minimum Qualifications:

Qualifying Personnel include an individual who is able to support students and model strategies for school staff under the supervision of a licensed Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA).

Additional qualifications:

- an RBT (Registered Behavior Technician)
 - *and/or*
- an individual willing to earn a Registered Behavior Technician license (provided by NUES)
- Ability to coach and model with educators and student guardians regarding intervention of the student's behavior needs; removing barriers to learning and developing skills and behaviors critical for the student's academic achievement
- Documentation of successful work history experience
- Willingness to work under the supervision and consultation of BCBA's, with ability to follow education laws and procedures, including Special Education law, as guided by the BCBA
- Ability to understand school system procedures and policies
- Commitment to the importance that positive behavior supports and intervention services play in the overall education of a student
- Ability to work cooperatively with students, their parents, LEA staff and school community
- Commitment to collaboration, teaming and in working with a professional learning community

- Valid Utah Driver's license and the ability to drive own vehicle

Desired Prerequisites:

Prior experience in a public-school setting

High school diploma as a minimum, preferred

Compensation:

The beginning hourly rate is \$30/hour and is commensurate with qualifications and experience. Mileage reimbursement will be provided. This will be a six-month position, up to 20 hours/week, beginning January 6, 2025 with possibility to extend to a full-year contract for the 2025-2026 school year.
